Tim Showers – Part-Time Seasonal Employee – Tim Showers was hired as a seasonal part-time pool pesticide employee at \$7.25 an hour for any time submitted.

Lifeguards - Discussion was held on the township's need for lifeguards.

Employee Wages - After discussion was held on the need for lifeguards, Mike Spangler made a motion to recommend approval of a starting lifeguard receiving \$8.50 an hour and a returning lifeguard receiving \$8.75 an hour, a starting concession worker receiving \$7.25 an hour and a returning concession worker receiving \$7.50 an hour, plus any lifeguard obtaining a new life guard certificate that works 160 hrs will be reimbursed half their lifeguard certification fee, seconded by Jay Rhoads. All voted in favor.

Pool Opening and Closing Date – June 9<sup>th</sup> with a closing date in August to be determined.

Noah and Company's Request – Mike Olesh made a motion to approve Noah and Company's request to rent the pool one time a week for 7 weeks, seconded by Jay Rhoads. All voted in favor.

ADJOURNMENT – Jay Rhoads made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:20 p.m., seconded by Mike Olesh. All voted in favor.
