PARK AND RECREATION BOARD MINUTES
MAY 4, 2016

ROLL CALL - The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Mike Spangler, Mike Olesh, and Phil Tipton were in attendance. Jay Rhoads was absent. The meeting was held at the Bethel Township Municipal Building, 3015 S. Pine Grove Street, Fredericksburg, PA.

COMMENTS - None.

MINUTES - Phil Olesh made a motion to approve the March minutes as presented, seconded by Phil Tipton. All voted in favor.

OLD BUSINESS

Parking Lot – Mike Olesh made a motion to approve advertising for the paving of the parking lots at the park, seconded by Phil Tipton. All voted in favor.

NEW BUSINESS

Interviews – Will be scheduled for May 13th.

Splash Party Agreements – Some changes will be made to the application, adding the time 7:30 pm – 9:30 pm, tobacco free and some other minor changes.

Dogs in Park - There is a problem with someone smearing dog waste on the garbage cans. The cans will be moved in camera view.

Park Signs - Phil Tipton made a motion to approve purchasing the signs needed at the park, seconded by Mike Olesh. All voted in favor.

Aqua Zumba - Phil Tipton made a motion to propose to Denise Swonger that she pay the township approximately \$20.00 or the appropriate amount to cover the township expenses, to use the pool to hold the Aqua Zumba classes after the pool closes on Tuesday and Thursday, and that she signs a hold harmless agreement, seconded by Mike Olesh. All voted in favor.

ADJOURNMENT - Phil Tipton made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:34 p.m., seconded by Mike Olesh. All voted in favor.
