2018 Season Passes – Jay Rhoads made a motion to charge \$60.00 for 60 yrs and older for NLSD residents and non- residents, \$75.00 for individual passes for NLSD residents and \$100.00 for non-residents, \$160.00 families up to four (4) family members and \$10.00 each for additional family members for NLSD residents and \$200.00 families up to four (4) family members and \$10.00 each for additional family members for non-residents, and \$10.00 off for early bird special through April 30, 2018, seconded by Mike Spangler. All voted in favor.
